## SANTA CLARA SWIM CLUB SCSC vs DART PACIFIC SWIMMING SHORT COURSE DUAL MEET OCTOBER 28-29, 2023



**SANCTION:** Held under USA/Pacific Swimming Sanction No. **23-136**

**USE OF AUDIO AND VISUAL:** Photography and video recording from behind the blocks or starting areas is prohibited unless prior permission is granted by the Meet Referee. Use of any audio or visual recording devices, including but not limited to film and digital cameras, cell phones and tablets, and Google Glass is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Violation of this recording prohibition may result in ejection from the swimming pool facility by the Meet Referee or his/her designee.

LOCATION: GEORGE G. HAINES INTERNATIONAL SWIM CENTER, 2625 PATRICIA DR, SANTA CLARA, CA 95051

**DIRECTIONS:** From Highway 101, exit south on Lawrence Expressway or Bowers Avenue. Turn left at Homestead Road. Turn left at Las Palmas Drive. Proceed to Patricia Drive and turn left. - Or - Exit Highway 101 on San Tomas Expressway. Turn right on Homestead Road. Turn right on Las Palmas. Proceed to Patricia Drive and turn left. There is limited free parking in the parking lot and adjoining streets. Do not park in the library parking lot you will be ticketed.

**COURSE:** OUTDOOR 25 YARD pool with up to two courses available for preliminary competition (9 lanes and 7 lanes). Relays will be run in the 9-lane course prior to the distance events. An additional 6 lanes will be available for warm-up/cool down throughout the competition. The minimum water depth for the shallow end course, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 4'6" at the start end and 4'6" at the turn end. The meet host will ensure the required course dimensions.

**TIME:** The meet will begin at 9:00am on Saturday and Sunday, with warm-ups from 7:30-8:45am. The facility/gate will open at 7:30am each day.

**RULES:** • Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules and warm-up procedures will govern the meet. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course.

• The local facilities guidelines, restrictions and interpretation of the local public health guidelines shall be followed at this

meet.

- All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- All events are timed finals.
- All events will swim fast to slow.
- Athletes may compete in 4 events per day.
- All Athletes ages 12 and under should complete competition within four (4) hours.
- All Coaches and Officials must wear their USA Swimming membership cards in a visible manner.
- The 500 free, 1650 Free and 400 IM events require positive check-in to swim these events.
- Athletes shall provide their own timers and lap counters for the 500 Free and 1650 Free events. Those events require a confirmed USA-S Swimming "B" Time, or a Coach Verified "B" time to enter.
- **Relays:** Relay cards are due by 10 AM. Only athletes entered in the meet are eligible for relays. Each team may enter 2 relays per age group. No entry fees charged for relays.

**UNACCOMPANIED ATHLETES:** Any USA Swimming Athlete-Member competing at the meet must be accompanied by a USA Swimming Member-Coach for the purposes of Athlete supervision during warm-up, competition and warm-down. If a Member Coach of the Athlete's USA Swimming Club does not attend the meet to serve in said supervisory capacity, it is the responsibility of the Athlete or the Athlete's legal guardian to arrange for supervision by a USA Swimming Member-Coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the Athlete in making arrangements for such supervision; however, it is recommended that such arrangements be made in advance of the meet by the Athlete's USA Swimming Club Member-Coach.

**RACING STARTS:** Athletes must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start the race in the water. It is the responsibility of the Athlete or the Athlete's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**RESTRICTIONS:** • Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in spectator seating, on standing areas and in all areas used by Athletes, during the meet and during warm-up periods.

- Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.
- No glass containers are allowed in the meet venue.
- No tent set up on the pool deck or in the stadium for athletes. Tents are allowed outside the pool gates (not blocking walkways) and may not be left overnight.
- Only stadium style chairs are allowed in the stadium. All others will be asked to be folded/removed. Do not set up in any walkways. All walkways must remain clear. No pets are allowed in the facility.
- No propane heater is permitted except for snack bar/meet operations.
- All shelters must be properly secured.
- Deck Changes are prohibited.
- Destructive devices, to include but not limited to, explosive devices and equipment, firearms (open or concealed), blades, knives, mace, stun guns and blunt objects are strictly prohibited in the swimming facility and its surrounding areas. If observed, the Meet Referee or his/her designee may ask that these devices be stored safely away from the public or removed from the facility. Noncompliance may result in the reporting to law enforcement authorities and ejection from the facility. Law enforcement officers (LEO) are exempt per applicable laws.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, Athlete/Coach areas, Spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time Athletes, Coaches, Officials and/or Spectators are present.

**ELIGIBILITY:** • Athletes must be current members of USA Swimming and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their USA Swimming Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the Athlete with the registration and times database. The Meet Host will check all Athlete registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the swimmer(s) will not be allowed to compete.

- Meet is open only to athletes registered or UN and training with SCSC and DART.
- Entries with "NO TIME" will be accepted with the exception of the 1650 Free and the 500 Free. Those events require a confirmed or coach verified USA-S "B" time.
- Disabled Athletes are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding any special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy.
- The Athlete's age will be the age of the Athlete on the first day of the meet.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$4.50 per event plus a \$10.00 participation fee per Athlete. All entry fees shall be included with entry. No refunds will be made, except mandatory scratch downs.

**TEAM ENTRIES:** A sd3 entry file must be submitted by Friday, October 20, 2023. Payment for entries is due prior to the start of the first session of the meet. Email entry file to <a href="mailto:jcorrigan@santaclaraswimclub.org">jcorrigan@santaclaraswimclub.org</a>.

**CHECK-IN:** The meet will be pre-seeded. Athletes entered and wanting to swim the 400 IM, 500 Free and 1650 Free must check-in by 10:00am on the day they are to be swum.

ADMISSION: Free.

MISCELLANEOUS: • No overnight parking is allowed. Facilities will not be provided after meet hours.

- A snack bar will be available during the meet.
- Hospitality will be available for Coaches and Officials working the meet.
